**PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF HEAD OFFICE BUILDING AT
TOWER HILL, FREETOWN**

The Anti Corruption Commission has received funds from the Government of Sierra Leone for the construction of its Head Office Building at Tower Hill in Freetown and now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction of the Building.

The Building is three storeys high plus a basement floor enclosing a total floor area of approximately 1981 square metres. It has reinforced concrete foundations and frame. External walls are a combination of blockwork and aluminum curtain walls. The roof is reinforced concrete. Internal walls are mostly in block work and a few aluminum partitions. Floors are finished in porcelain tiles throughout whilst ceilings in most areas are acoustic tiles.

Bidding is open to Local and International contractors who can demonstrate the ability to undertake this work and complete same to a very high standard and according to specifications in contract time. Local bidders should be registered with the Ministry of Works in Premier Class and able to demonstrate that they are in possession of sufficient human, technical and financial resources and administrative and organizing ability to perform the Contract.

Interested bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding document at the address below between **10:00am and 1:00pm daily**. Bidding documents may be purchased upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Le500, 000.00 (Five Hundred Thousand Leones)**.

Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **18th January 2012 at 12:00 noon**. All bids must be accompanied by:

- ❑ A bid security of **Le150,000,000.00 (One Hundred and Fifty Million Leones)** or its equivalence in a freely convertible currency
- ❑ a valid tax certificate;
- ❑ A list of projects the bidder has undertaken in the past or is currently undertaking indicating location, a brief description of each project, the Contract Sums, the dates of completion and the current percentage completion
- ❑ A list of all materials and equipment which the Contractor may wish to import for this project with their respective quantities and prices and an overall total.

Bids will be opened on **18 January 2012 at 12:00 noon** in the presence of representatives of bidders who choose to attend, at the address below. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened to bidders.
