EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

The Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Food Security (MAFFS) has a small consignment of functional sea vessels consisting of a landing craft and two speed boats. MAFFS is interested in entering into a public/private partnership agreement with a private Management Contractor for the purpose of undertaking commercial running of the vessels under the oversight of a standing committee comprising of representatives of several Government Ministries. Proceeds from the venture will be shared between the Management Contractor and Government on a formula basis. The Management Contractor shall have full responsibility for the running, maintenance, and upkeep of the vessels.

Interested Management Contractors (MC) are requested to visit MAFFS at Youyi Building, to obtain the locations of the vessels at their own cost, with a view of inspecting them and collecting necessary information for submission of an EOI. The EOI should contain the following:

1. A description of the company's profile indicating its background and track record,
2. A description of the legal existence of the company such as a registered Certificate of Incorporation, and Municipal/Local Council Registration Certificate,
3. An indication that the company is a compliant corporate body, such as possessing a NASSIT clearance certificate and Tax clearance certificate, and
4. A company Organogram.

Short-listed MCs must be willing to make a clear PowerPoint presentation on how their proposal will result in the best returns to Government in terms of proceeds. The proposal should include estimates of projected operational and maintenance costs, and expected proceeds. The

presentation should be logical and realistic, focusing on the most efficient utilization of the vessels for the best returns to Government.

Short-listed MC's shall receive RFP's to complete and submit to MAFFS for evaluation. Only one successful MC shall be selected for the award of the contract.
